Scott Peters supports the Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act and sees it as an important step forward. Scott wants his daughter and all women to have the same opportunities and level of reward — as men.

#### Equal Pay



Brian Bilbray voted against the Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act, which helps women prove pay discrimination.<sup>1</sup> Women still only earn 78 cents on the dollar,<sup>2</sup> and earn \$434,000 less than men over a 40-year career.<sup>3</sup>



Scott believes decisions about reproductive health are private, personal and between a woman, her doctor and her family. That's why Scott is endorsed by the Planned Parenthood Action Fund.

#### Women's Health Care Decisions



Brian Bilbray doesn't think women should have the right to make decisions about their own bodies. Instead, Bilbray wants to dictate women's personal health decisions. Also, Bilbray repeatedly voted to defund Planned Parenthood.<sup>4</sup>



Scott is running because he believes Congress is broken, and nothing will change until we change the people we send to Washington. Scott is focused on helping create jobs and grow the economy, not dictating women's personal health decisions.

#### Changing Congress



Brian Bilbray votes with the Tea Party leadership 90% of the time,<sup>5</sup> the same leadership that's tried to pass 30 bills in the last two years restricting women's reproductive rights.<sup>6</sup> Bilbray's votes hurt women, and the only way to change Congress is to change the people we send there.
